SEASON 2011-12 SENIOR LEAGUE FIXTURES

HOW THE LEAGUES WORK

Each of the Senior, Intermediate and Junior Leagues play both League and Cup competitions.

There are eight teams in the Senior League this season.

There are league winners and runners up for both parts of the league (played before and after Christmas).

A set of trophies will be awarded to league winners and runners-up for both the pre Christmas League and also for the post Christmas League.

The Cup Competition starts with two groups of four teams. Quarter Finals are held depending on the results and positions of teams in their respective group followed by Cup and Plate Semi-Finals. The Finals are played before Gala Day.

Fixtures and Postponements

Unless you are advised by your manager all games will be played in accordance with the fixture list (overleaf).

If games have to be postponed (by inclement weather) you will be advised by your manager. If this happens, we will award a 0-0 result and continue the next Saturday with the fixture list. If the council allows we will catch up with the missing game later. The exception to this is that knockout games all games that impact the final league positions will be re-played as determined by the committee.

If we have a large number of postponements we will issue revised fixture lists.
